ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

Anglo Institut der Sprache - Anglo-German Institute is located on a side street in the very heart of the town center. Shops, cafes, restaurants and public transport are close at hand. The school opened in 1972, teaching only English as a foreign language. At the beginning of the 1980s, Anglo Institut der Sprache began to offer German language courses through its German Language Center which is dedicated exclusively to teaching German as a foreign language. All teachers are specially trained in teaching German as a foreign language. The school is equipped with audio and video facilities. The groups are limited to 10 participants. Anglo Institut der Sprache is well-known for its relaxed and friendly atmosphere, and teachers are always ready to chat over a cup of coffee or to offer advice.

As the capital of Baden-Württemberg, Stuttgart is a pleasant, lively city and one of the most prosperous, export orientated "Länder" (States) in the Federal Republic, situated in South-West Germany. Stuttgart has a good central location, with Basle, Strasbourg and Munich only a few hours' drive away on the freeway. The cultural diversity in the city of Stuttgart is impressive: there is a wide variety of theaters, a symphony orchestra, and the Stuttgart Ballet is internationally renowned.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Anglo Institut der Sprache courses help students to master the German language systematically, covering all important areas: * Speaking well * Understanding spoken German * Writing accurately * Understanding written German. All language classes are 45 minutes in duration. Anglo Institut der Sprache offers 6 levels of instruction: Beginners, Elementary I & II, Intermediate I & II, Advanced .

Standard Course

Group 20 hours per week. The Standard courses comprise 20 lessons per week in a small group setting of 5 - 10 students maximum. Courses for beginners usually start every 6-8 weeks. Those with previous knowledge do a placement test and join a suitable course any Monday. Courses last from 2 to 50 weeks.

Intensive Course

Group/Tutor 30 hours per week. The Intensive course combines the Standard group course with 10 additional hours per week of one-on-one tutorial. The individual lessons usually consist of a recapitulation and reinforcement of the morning lessons, but often students have special requests, such as Goethe Institute or PND exam preparation, or they might want to customize their program during these tutorials by selecting either Business German Phonetics or Vocabulary. Expansion Specialized Vocabulary.

Language & Culture Course - Summer Only

During the summer months, Anglo Institut der Sprache offers Language & Culture courses at fixed starting times. These courses consist of lessons in the mornings and a guided activity program in the afternoons. At weekends, various excursions are on offer to the Black Forest, to festivals and sports events, to beautiful medieval towns and to the outstanding countryside around Stuttgart. The courses last from 2 to 10 weeks, and are conducted in small groups of between 5 and 10 students. Levels range from absolute beginners to upper intermediate. Extra individual tuition can be added upon request and at additional cost. Anglo Institut der Sprache's qualified and experienced teachers conduct classes in a relaxed but productive atmosphere, introducing real-life German in realistic situations.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Homestays

Families are carefully selected and the school asks students to fill out a homestay evaluation so school administrators can monitor how students and family members are getting along. Most families are within easy reach of the Institute, with a typical journey time is about 30 minutes. Lodging in a single room with breakfast daily is included. Students will receive full details two weeks before arrival.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

Stuttgart offers a wide range of cultural opportunities including visits to museums and exhibitions, concerts, theatres, cinemas, places of historic interest in and around Stuttgart. The city is also offers horseback riding, football, swimming, tennis, athletics, cycle racing and much more. Anglo Institut der Sprache plans visits to the Mercedes-Benz Museum, the oldest car manufacturer in the world, and sometimes arranges for staff and students to meet in the evenings in one of the Swabian wine bars or restaurants. In non-summer months, Anglo Institut der Sprache plans activities in consultation with students.

Programs

The German courses help students to master the German language systematically, covering all important areas:

Admissions & Academic Credit

Students age 18 years and older are welcomed regardless of educational background, occupation or nationality. No previous knowledge of German is required except where otherwise indicated.

Students desiring credit for their study should contact their home school or request the NRCSA Credit Fact Sheet. Generally, U.S. universities consider 15 hours of study to be equal to 1 semester credit.
